Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), a statutory body has been established under provisions of the Energy Conservation Act 2001, to institutionalize and establish delivery mechanism for energy efficiency services, with the objective of reducing wasteful use of energy in the Indian Economy.

BEE invites **Engineers / Scientists / Economists / MBAs** with outstanding academic/work records to join its team on direct recruitment on contract basis / deputation basis:

Job description: Undertake policy research and formulate policies and programmes for efficient use of energy and its conservation, strengthen energy auditing / energy management capabilities in the country, assist in implementation of energy efficiency programmes, benchmark energy consumption in industry, power generation, transmission & distribution, promote energy efficient technologies, design and implement Demand Side Management, design and implement Standard & Labelling programme for appliances, assist in preparation of Energy Conservation Building Codes (ECBC) and co-ordinate with State Authorities in implementation, promote awareness and implement programmes for school children, develop performance contract and promote Energy Service Companies (ESCOs), develop innovative financial mechanism for adoption of Energy Efficiency in Industries and Commerce.

Number of Positions: Four

Educational & Other qualifications: *Essentials for direct recruits / deputation:* A Master's degree in Physics/Chemistry or Economics/Applied Economics / Energy Planning & Economics or a Bachelors degree in Engineering from a recognized University or Institute.

Desirable: A doctoral degree in Economics/Applied Economics/Energy planning or equivalent or a Masters degree in Engineering / Economics/Business / Industrial / Systems Management. Research experience of two years and / or research publications of high standard published in referred journals, an over-all perspective of National Energy problems and policies with thrust on Energy Efficiency and its conservation.

Experience: *Direct recruit:* **A minimum of 10 years experience** in Research / Development / Design / Academic / Government Departments / Institutes / Organisations dealing with Energy efficiency or its conservation, and energy auditing and other related areas.

Deputation: Officers of the Central/State Governments/Public Sector Undertakings/Universities/Recognised Research Institutions holding Group A or equivalent post **for a minimum of 10 years and possessing educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits.**

Terms of Employment: Employment will be on contract basis and the initial contract would be for a period of five years. The contract may be renewed after the expiry of the initial contract period.

Scale of Pay: Rs.14300-400-18300. Dearness Allowances (DA), City Compensatory Allowance (CCA) and House Rent Allowance (HRA) etc. as per Central Government rules. Total emoluments at the minimum of pay-scale at present are Rs.28,147/- per month.

Age Limit: Maximum 50 years as on 1st January 2004, **relaxible by 5 years in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates.**

Place of Posting: **Successful applicants would be posted in New Delhi. They can, however, be posted any where in India.**
