## ATTENTION DESIGNATED CONSUMERS

### UNDER THE ENERGY CONSERVATION ACT, 2001

#### ARE YOU A MAJOR USER or CLASS OF USERS OF ENERGY IN THE ENERGY INTENSIVE INDUSTRIES specified in the Schedule to the Act?

The Central Government in exercise of powers conferred by the clauses (e) and (f) of Section 14 of the Energy Conservation Act, 2001(52 of 2001) has specified vide S.O.394(E) dated the 12th March, 2007 published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II-Section 3-sub-section (ii) dated March 19, 2007, the following users or class of users of Energy Intensive Industries and establishments as designated consumers:-

1.	Thermal Power Stations	30,000
2.	Fertilizers	30,000
3.	Cement	30,000
4.	Iron and Steel	30,000
5.	Chlor-Alkali	12,000
6.	Aluminium	7,500
7.	Textile	3,000
8.	Pulp and Paper	30,000

The Central Government has issued directions vide S.O. 318(E) dated the 2nd March, 2007 notified in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary-Part II-Section 3-Sub-section (ii) dated March 5, 2007 that (i) every designated consumer shall designate or appoint an energy manager; and (ii) submit a report in electronic form and in hard copy to the concerned State Designated Agency with a copy to the Bureau of Energy Efficiency on the status of energy consumption at the end of every financial year as prescribed in the Energy Conservation (the form and manner for submission of report on the status of energy consumption by the designated consumers) Rules, 2007 published under GSR.174(E). dated March 2, 2007 in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II -Section -3(i) dated March 5, 2007.

This is to inform you that under the Perform, Achieve & Trade (PAT) component of NMEEE, every DC would be required to reduce the Specific Energy Consumption (SEC) by certain target within a timeframe. It is required that each DC will have to submit the energy consumption returns in the notified format for 2005-06 to 2009-10 by the 15th March 2011.

All the aforesaid DC are informed to comply with the above directions. The State Designated Agencies shall enforce the above provisions and initiate action for imposition of penalty under the Energy Conservation Act, 2001 ( 52 of 2001 ) on such DC's who fail to comply with the directions as specified above. All the DC should fill the Form available at web site <https://beenet.gov.in/BEEefiling/main.jsp> (for e-filing) and [http://www.bee-india.nic.in/content.php?page=miscellaneous/designated\\_consumers.php](http://www.bee-india.nic.in/content.php?page=miscellaneous/designated_consumers.php) (for downloading and printing) and submit the same, duly completed and authenticated by energy manager, the Chief Executive or his nominee for the purpose, to the concerned State Designated Agencies with a copy to the Bureau of Energy Efficiency.
