- Project Description:** The project aims at preparing the ground for the multiplication of the CO<sub>2</sub> management approach in China in the larger scale. To this end the project will provide capacity building through the development of expert skills in the field of CO<sub>2</sub> management for the Industry in the People's Republic of China.
- Project Objectives:** The project addresses the need to manage CO<sub>2</sub> emissions in the industry as main source of anthropogenic CO<sub>2</sub> emissions in China. With respect to this problem, the overall objectives of the project are:
- 1) Improve the environmental (resource/energy efficient) and economical (cost efficient) performance of the Chinese industry by more efficient use of energy resulting from sound CO<sub>2</sub> management;
  - 2) Strengthen the technology dialog and partnership between Europe and China concerning CO<sub>2</sub> and climate change, to feasible common efforts of two important economies to meet their global responsibility;
  - 3) Prepare the ground for co-operation on concrete technology levels, expressed for example in terms of emission trading, by generating a common understanding and by harmonizing and standardizing approaches.
