Background

As per the Energy Conservation Act 2001, it is mandatory for designated Energy consumers to appoint an “Energy Managers / Energy Auditors”. As per the Act, the designated energy managers will also have to appear for a national level certification examination and have to pass the same.

TERI, with its vast experience in the field of industrial energy efficiency/energy audit, proposes to conduct one more ‘Preparatory coaching programme’ for those who aspire to appear for examination to become qualified energy managers / energy auditors.

This intensive coaching programme will provide adequate background on the subject and followed by cases wherever required. All these help in preparing for the examination proposed.

Examination Papers

For Energy Managers Paper 1,2 & 3 are applicable and for Energy Auditors, all the four papers are applicable

Duration of the Course

The course will be of six days duration, with class room sessions, demonstration of portable energy audit instruments, and exposure to successful case studies and question bank with worksheets wherever applicable. For each section / paper will have different types of questions made available to understand the concepts / approach.

Course fee

Rs 12,500/- per candidate for the **course of six days**. The above course fee is inclusive of noon lunch and also tea / coffee (morning and evening).

For participants needing residential accommodation, a limited number of rooms are also available on twin sharing basis, at TERI-SRC Domlur office, Bangalore. The rates per person will be Rs 375/- per day for double room non-AC, Rs 500/- per day for a non-AC suite and Rs 625/- for an AC suite (on room only basis). Since the accommodation available is limited, it is necessary that participants desirous of availing this facility make an advance payment of Rs 3,000/- per person towards accommodation along with the course fee, subject to final adjustment before leaving this place.

Faculty

The faculty is largely drawn from expert professionals from the Industrial Energy Group at TERI-Southern Regional Centre, having extensive experience in undertaking efficiency programmes for various industries all over India and also abroad. Most of the faculty members are also trained in Germany and have exposure to international practices on energy efficiency.

This six days course will help the participants to appear for the 'National Certification Examination' for Energy Managers / Energy Auditors more confidently.
