

## Technical Exhibition



**8-11 November 2005, New Delhi - India**

### Introduction

The technical exhibition being organized concurrently with Ninth NCB International Seminar is intended to provide a state-of-art review of developments in technologies relating to manufacture and utilization of cement and other related building materials in terms of processes and systems, equipment and machinery, instrumentation and controls. This will include a display of equipment, scale models, components, posters, charts, photographs, publications etc.

### Service Charges

Stalls of various sizes with all facilities for effective display will be provided. The tentative layout is enclosed. The service charges for booking of stall shall be Rs.9000/- per sq.m for Indian Exhibitors and US \$ 900 per sq.m for Overseas Exhibitors, which include lunch, welcome dinner and Tea/Coffee facilities for three representatives of each exhibitor for category A stall and two representatives of each exhibitor for category B and C stalls. Out of the above, one representative of each stall shall be treated as a delegate of the seminar. Each exhibitor shall also be provided an opportunity to make a technical presentation (about 10 minutes) to the delegates in a special session.

### Facilities

- Stalls covered on three sides with PVC laminated prefabricated aluminium system display panels
- Fascia with provision for displaying the name of the company/organization
- Tables and chairs, 3 Nos for category A and 2 Nos each for category B and C stalls
- Spot lights, 6 Nos for category A and 4 Nos each for category B and C stalls
- 15 amp power point 230 V AC, 50 Hz, 2 Nos for category A and 1 No. for category B and C stalls

*Note: Nailing, painting & stickers shall not be allowed on the panels & framing system*

The following facilities can be made available on request, subject to availability, upon payment of actual charges:

- Additional power sockets (*please indicate load current*)
- Additional furniture (*please specify dimension*)

Telephone/ Fax services will be available at the venue of the Seminar on payment. However, the facilities for audio-visual display (TV/VCR) inside the stall shall have to be arranged by the exhibitors themselves.

### **Duration of Exhibition**

The exhibits should be placed in position in the allotted stall by 0930 hrs on 8 November 2005 as the inauguration of the exhibition is tentatively scheduled in the forenoon. For this purpose, the exhibitors shall have access to their stalls at about 0800 hrs on 8 November 2005. Further, the exhibition shall remain open from 0930 to 1730 hrs during the period 8-11 November 2005.

### **Allocation of Stalls**

There being only a limited number of stalls, the allotment shall be made on first-come-first-served basis on receipt of request on the prescribed booking form duly accompanied by the remittance towards service charges. Normally, not more than one stall shall be allocated to each exhibitor. Depending on the availability, however, request for additional stalls can also be considered. Allotment of specific stalls shall be made by NCB and this shall be final. Subletting or sharing of the allotted stall is not permitted. Stall booked by Indian agents for their foreign principals shall be permitted on payment of service charges in US \$ only.

### **Cancellation**

Fifty percent of the advance amount shall be refunded on request for cancellation of booking received not later than 10 August 2005. No claim of refund shall be admissible thereafter.

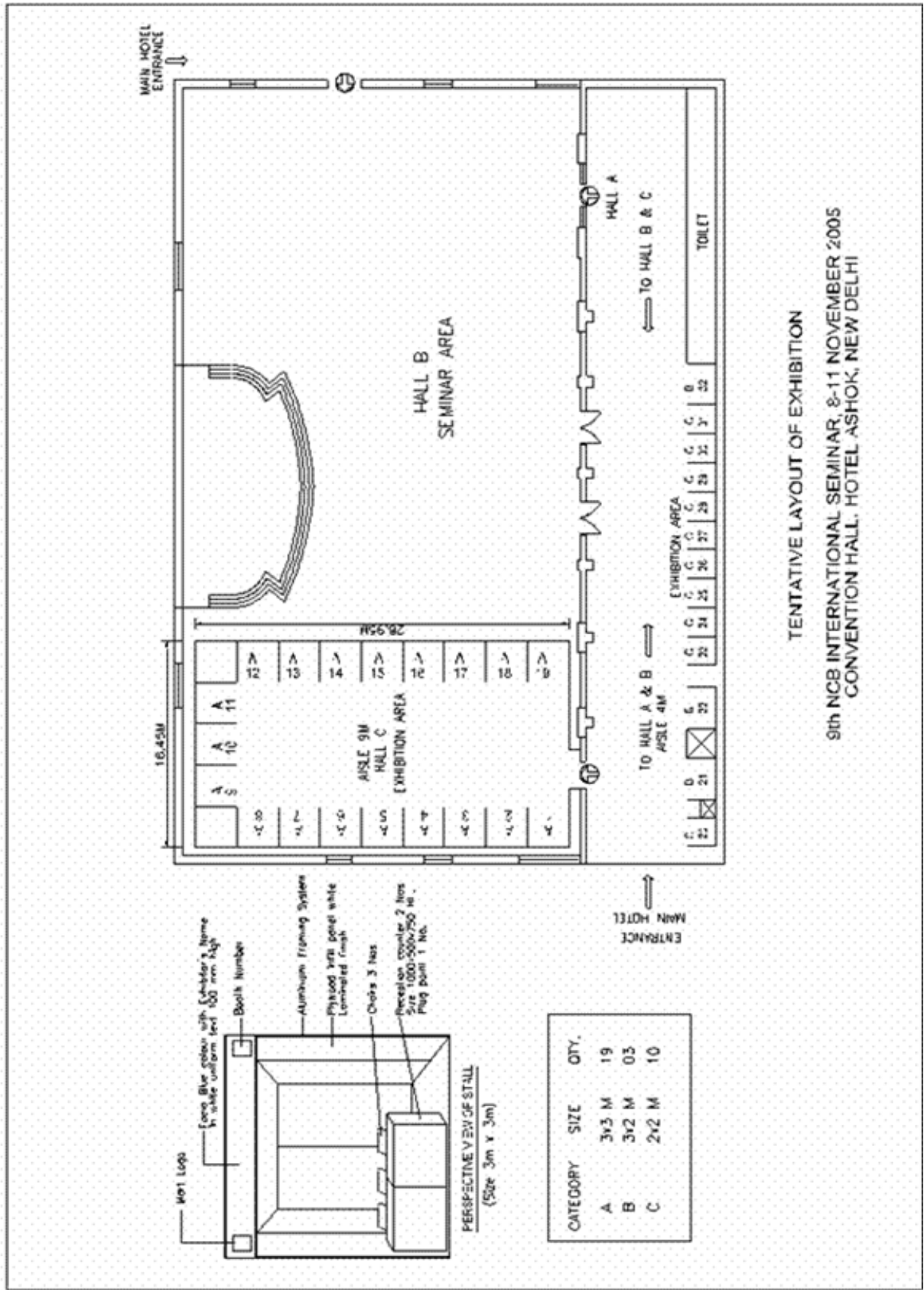
### **Safety and Insurance of Exhibits**

The safety and security of exhibits shall be the responsibility of the concerned exhibitors. However, necessary assistance shall be provided by NCB to the extent possible. Exhibitors are advised to take adequate safety measures against fire hazard and not to bring exhibits which are inflammable. Exhibitors are also advised to get their exhibits duly insured. All the exhibitors and their representatives shall abide by the security regulations of the venue.

### **General Terms & Conditions**

NCB shall have the sole discretion

- To reject any application of space without assigning any reason
- To shift the venue of the exhibition to any other site in the NCT of Delhi without prior notice to the exhibitors due to force majeure conditions
- To change the dates & duration of the exhibition without prior notice to the exhibitors
- To recover from the exhibitors, compensation for losses/damages caused to the property or reasonable penalty for any willful contravention of the terms for participation
- To refuse permission to any exhibitor to clear the stall, if all dues are not paid to the organizers.
