## **India M&V and IPMVP Training**

**New Delhi, 24 April, 2008**

A one-day training programme on the value of measurement and verification (M&V) and the implementation of the International Performance Measurement & Verifications Protocol (IPMVP) will be held on the 24<sup>th</sup> of April - for the first time in India - at the India International Centre Annexe, New Delhi.

Organized by: Conzerv Systems Pvt Ltd. in partnership with The Efficiency Valuation Organization (EVO), the developer of the IPMVP, and USAID-ECO-III project (through IRG and Alliance to Save Energy (ASE)).

This program objective is to develop the understanding of energy efficiency professionals about M&V, the range of methods, the existence of an international standard (unbiased yet technically rigorous approach) and the need for specific M&V design for each project. The First session will introduce the basic concepts of M&V and the latest version of IPMVP. The Second session will cover the application of ideas introduced in the First session using the four IPMVP options, followed by an Interactive Question-Answer session.

This programme will provide the introduction and background information for those seeking enhanced skills about how to implement M&V in their projects in a consistent and reliable manner. It will guide those who want to take up the advanced Certified Performance Measurement and Verification Professional Program to become qualified International M&V Trainers (see [www.evo-world.org](http://www.evo-world.org)). For non-technical / financial audience, it will provide assurance that project implementers are providing a serious and legitimate service and help them speak the language of energy efficiency.

**Participants:** The programme is intended for energy-efficient project developers, implementers and practitioners, Carbon-reduction projects and CDM validators, Certified Energy Auditors and Managers and those who want an in-depth understanding of M&V concepts, including Financiers, Utilities (Demand Side Program managers and implementers), large energy users (e.g., facility owners/managers), government officials and regulatory agencies.
