You will be then required to send two good quality hard copies along with soft copy through e-mail / CD containing the word file of your presentation before 31st December 2008 in an envelope marked as 'Paper/Poster Presentation'.
- Acceptance for presentation is subject to review by the Technical Committee. Prior acceptance is pre-requisite for presentation in the Poster Session.

About Goa

Situated on the Malabar Coast, the land of fun, sun and elation Goa is smallest state of India in terms of area and fourth smallest in term of population. Goa is also called the beach capital of India and famous for its beautiful and golden beaches.

On the world horizon, Goa is one of the most popular tourist destinations. A tiny emerald land on the western coast of India, Goa is famous among tourists from around the world for its stunning beaches dotted with palm coconut trees, beautiful rivers & lakes, cruises, water fun, exotic cuisine and mouth-watering seafood, beach parties such as trance party, nightlife, casino, festivals such as Goa Carnival - a three days non stop festival of fun and elation, magnificent churches, temples and wildlife.

Beaches

Anjuna - 18 km from Panaji and adjacent to Chapora Fort, it was the haunt of the flower generation in the sixties and still popular with the younger generation. A key attraction here is a magnificent Albuquerque Mansion built in 1920, flanked by octagonal towers and an attractive Mangalore tile-roof.

Others: Calangute, Dona Paula, Agonda, Arambol, Baga, Betul, Colva, Miramar, Palolem, Polem, Vagator

Churches

Se Cathedral at Old Goa - The largest church in Asia, the cathedral in Old Goa, is a mighty 16th century monument to the Roman Catholic rule of Goa under the Portuguese. It's huge Golden Bell is the biggest in the world. The Church has 14 side chapels; the last chapel, in Mauresque style, preserves a cross upon which a vision of Christ is said to have appeared in 1919.

Others: Church of St. Francis of Assisi at Old Goa, Bom Jesus Basilica, St. Cajetan Church, Church of the Lady of the Mount, St. Augustine Tower, Santa Monica cloister

Temples

Shri Mangueshi Temple - dedicated to Lord Shiva, is 22 km from Panaji at Priol-Ponda Taluka. Though small, it has an air of distinctive elegance. Its lofty white tower at the entrance is a landmark of the countryside.

Shri Shantadurga Temple - Kavlem - Built at Kavlem, it is dedicated to Shantadurga. The temple has an impressive idol of Goddess Durga in a tranquil mood, flanked by Vishnu and Shiva. Agrashalas provide lodging facilities to the devotees

Others: Shri Mahalaxmi at Bandora, Shri Nagesh at Bandora, Shri Bhagavati Temple, Shri Mahalsa at Mardol, Shri Chandranath at Quepem.

Forts

Aguada Fort - was built by the Portuguese in 1609-1612, to control the entry into the river Mandovi and to protect Old Goa from potential enemy attacks. A spring within the fort provided water supply to the ships that called there. The fort presently houses the Central Aguada Jail.

Others: Cabo Fort (Raj Bhavan), Chapora Fort, Terekhol (Tiracol) Fort

Sahakari Spice Farm - is situated amidst lush green surroundings at Curti. A place for relaxation under the dense forest cover, an aroma of a variety of genuine spices coming from the trees grown around the farm, lots of knowledge, guidance on the type of species and treatment for various diseases, sumptuous lunch in traditional Goan style, and other modes of entertainment, all this and more to add to a cherishable day at Sahakari Spice Farm.
