

Frequently Asked Questions – January 19, 2009

1. This is an open call and not restricted to any shortlisted agencies.
2. The names of the seven clusters are mentioned on pg 44. The 'units surveyed' should read as 'units listed'. The maximum number of surveyed units in any of these clusters is not more than 250.
3. The person-months have not been estimated since the effort required in different clusters will be different. The same must be estimated by the bidder.

Frequently Asked Question – January 22, 2009

1. The timelines given in the RFP (pg 39) are to be used to identify the end dates of activities. The bidders may propose earlier start and end of activities.

Frequently Asked Questions – February 3, 2009

1. There is a single bid processing fee of Rs 10,000/-. This fee is not 'per cluster'.
2. The findings of the situation analysis in the 7 clusters are now posted on the web alongwith this set of FAQs.

Frequently Asked Questions – February 4, 2009-02-04

1. The EMD should be separate for separate bids, and enclosed in respective envelopes. Please do not submit consolidated amounts in case submitting bids for more than one cluster.
2. The Bid Processing fee can be placed in any of the bids, as long as a reference of the location of the same is made in other bids if any.
3. Bids should be submitted separately for each cluster. Please do not club technical bids for different clusters. The same applies to financial bids.
