About four lakh students from 18000 schools across the country participated in the Painting Competition organized by the Ministry of Power through Bureau of Energy Efficiency. The state level painting competition was held on 14th November 2006 and winners from 35 States and Union Territories (2 each) participated in the final held in New Delhi today.
