A call to assist participants in the preparation of the national exam for certified energy managers and energy auditors

The annual examination for certified energy auditors and energy managers seems to be still very attractive for a large number of professional engineers. On the other hand the exam paper covers four diverse subjects which are difficult to handle by most of us. Most of us are specialising in one or two subjects. The average age of the last 4000 participants taken the exam was an astonishing 40 years.

We therefore do not deal with young post graduate students or engineers who have just started their professional career.

In order to assist applicants to prepare better for the next years exam the Indo-German Energy Programme (IGEN) in cooperation with Bureau of Energy Efficiency is inviting the best performers of the energy auditor examination of the last three years to become a focal point for a group of applicants preparing for the exam in their respective region.

We will organise this training online as a distant learning event. Focus will be on discussion and solving the exercises which are context sensitive to the content of the four books used as base for exam paper setters.

BEE and IGEN will assign 10 moderators who have passed the energy auditors exam and scored well. Each moderator will be available online for advice and guidance. He will also conduct review meetings in larger cities on weekends.

In a first step we look for 10 moderators who will be reimbursed for their efforts, through IGEN.
