Bachat Lamp Yojana



Concept Note on "Bachat Lamp Yojana" and Status - Bachat Lamp Yojana a CDM based CFL scheme is an innovative initiative put in place by the Central Government to enhance lighting efficiency in the Indian household sector by making Compact Fluorescent Lamps available at prices comparable to that of Incandescent Lamps. The scheme seeks to leverage the high cost of the CFLs through the CERs generated out of the project. "Bachat Lamp Yojana" seeks to utilize the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) of the Kyoto Protocol to bring-down the price of CFLs. This public-private partnership between the Government of India, Private sector CFL Manufacturers /Traders (Project Developers) and State level Electricity Distribution Companies would provide the framework to distribute high quality CFLs at about Rs.15 per piece to the households of the country. Under the scheme only 60 Watt and 100 Watt incandescent Lamps have to be replaced with 11 to 15 Watt and 20 - 25 Watt CFLs respectively.
